The “Society” a.k.a. “NSAS” is the Northern Sydney Astronomical Society Incorporated (Number Y0951224) and is incorporated in NSW. It operates as a Not-For-Profit association of members and is administered by a committee as appointed under the Society’s constitution (which can be found on the NSAS website (www.nsas.org.au)).

COVID Policy

Committee reserves rights

The Committee reserves the right to change or alter the Policy, from time to time and with no notice, as it sees fit to cater for exceptional circumstances. For example: - If a COVID case had been identified amongst the membership then the committee might restrict activities in any way it sees fit, including cancelling events at short notice, the wearing of masks or other accepted social distancing methods and including the requirement for evidence of vaccination status. The Committee can never adjust the Policy to be less restrictive than the NSW Govt Guidelines.

These rights require an appropriate committee meeting to be convened and the decision taken to amend the policy.
